








<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • BE – WAS / WERE – BEEN: ser / estar. • BECOME – BECAME – BECOME: llegar a ser. • BEGIN – BEGAN – BEGUN: empezar. • BREAK – BROKE – BROKEN: romper. • BUY – BOUGHT – BOUGHT: comprar. • BURN – BURNT – BURNT: quemar. • CHOOSE – CHOSE – CHOSEN: escoger, elegir.. • BRING – BROUGHT - BROUGHT: traer. • BLOW – BLEW – BLOWN: soplar. • COME – CAME – COME: venir. • COST – COST – COST: costar. • CUT – CUT – CUT: cortar. • CATCH – CAUGHT – CAUGHT: atrapar, coger. • DO – DID – DONE: hacer. • DRAW – DREW – DRAWN: dibujar. • FALL – FELL – FALLEN: caer(se). • FEEL – FELT – FELT: sentir. • GO – WENT – GONE: ir.

Other prepositions:

- **Away from:** She walked away from the river (se alejó del río andando).
- **Off:** She fell off her bike (se cayó de la bici).
- **Out of:** I ran out of my house (salí corriendo de mi casa).
- **Towards:** The girl came towards the building (la chica vino hacia el edificio).

- **Mistake:** error, equivocación.
- **Boss:** jefe.
- **Realize:** darse cuenta.
- **Lost:** perdido.
- **Jungle:** jungle.
- **Stay:** quedarse (stay at home: quedarse en casa).
