

Hi, everyone! Today, I am going to talk about something very important. Today is International Day for the Elimination of Violence Against Women.




Violence can happen to all people, but statistically, violence happens to women more than any other gender.




Violence can come in many forms. We will talk more about them during this presentation.




Here are some causes of violence against women around the world.




